THE BLUEPRINT

The Business Management Modernization Program is the largest transformation effort in the public or private sector.

Streamlining the Department's business and financial management processes and systems is a management challenge. It requires a plan that starts at the very foundation of the Department's business operations and management culture.

The centerpiece of BMMP is the transformational tool known as the Business Enterprise Architecture (BEA). The BEA is a blueprint to guide DoD's diverse business communities in transforming their processes and systems. It will describe the requirements that DoD business processes and systems must meet to achieve the goals of transformation.

A STRATEGY FOR SUCCESS

The strategy for success includes many integrated activities:

- a Business Enterprise Architecture that reflects streamlined processes and enables integration of systems;
- Department-wide governance process that describes how and by whom business transformation will be implemented;
- a Transition Plan that depicts the migration strategy from our legacy systems environment to the new mix of systems needed to reach our transformed state;
- an incremental approach to reengineer the Department's business processes;
- maximization of commercial-based solutions.



THE FOUNDATION FOR IT INVESTMENT

Public law, Section 8084 of the FY 2004 DoD Appropriations Act requires the Office of Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) to review and certify business system improvements exceeding \$1 million. This certification process applies to all business systems.

WORKING TOGETHER

The Department's functional business lines have the authority, responsibility, and accountability for working with you to transform the DoD. These business lines fall within the following Domains:

- Accounting & Finance
- Acquisition
- Human Resources Management
- Installations & Environment
- Logistics
- Strategic Planning & Budgeting

Though not a Domain, the Enterprise Information Environment (EIE) is a mission area that includes integrated information networks.

BMMP's transformation of business practices requires the active participation and support of all components of DoD - Military Departments, Defense Agencies, and DoD Field Activities - in order to successfully transform the DoD's business practices... and maximize military readiness.
