


Explanation: The Congress added \$2.0 million in FY 2001 for the Sentinel program for ADAS for Medium Brigade. The current Avenger system is being modified with a slew-to-cue (STC) capability, which is embedded into a new Avenger fire control computer. The intent of the increase was to evaluate the ADAS in conjunction with the Avenger STC platform. The ADAS will be evaluated on its effectiveness and the benefits it provides to the Avenger system. This evaluation should be conducted using Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army funding.
