This internal reprogramming action transfers \$48.282 million among various Operation & Maintenance (O&M) and Military Personnel appropriations to equitably distribute the foreign currency exchange rates reductions included in Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002, based on the exchange rates approved for execution. This transfer requires the use of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the FY 2002 DoD Appropriations Act, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the FY 2002 National Defense Authorization Act. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not been previously denied by the Congress.



Explanation: Section 8095 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002, reduced the O&M and Military Personnel appropriations by a total of \$240.0 million based on anticipated foreign currency rate gains. However, the congressional distribution of the reduction by appropriation is not consistent with the actual impact of such a change in foreign currency exchange rates. This action redistributes \$48.282 million of the congressional reduction to correct the distribution of this reduction by appropriation.
