

This internal reprogramming action transfers \$9.075 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, FY 2002, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 02/03, appropriation. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. Reclassification is required to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress.
