

SUBJECT: Interim Change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A, Regarding Basic Allowance for Subsistence Increases for CY 2001 (DFAS Item L-01)

The attached, Interim Change **04-02** to Chapter 25 of the Defense Financial Management Regulation (DoDFMR), Volume 7A, is effective January 1, 2002. This change incorporates Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) rate increase for CY 2002 into the DoDFMR. Policy changes to the BAS entitlement will be issued in a separate Interim Change.

This is a routine change and the result of directed action that does not affect existing policies. A draft of this change was not provided for comment. Assignment of the interim change number is your authority to initiate a procedural modification to implement this change. Use the attached to initiate the formal change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A.

BASIC ALLOWANCE FOR SUBSISTENCE RATE INCREASES FOR CY 2002

- Effective January 1, 2002, Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) rates for officers and enlisted members are established as monthly rates at the levels indicated below. Rates for Partial BAS and Emergency Rations, as well as, separate rates for enlisted members with less than 4 months of service have been eliminated.
