(DFAS Item No. F-52)

limitations on the number of days of accrued leave that may be
paid upon the death of a member on active duty.

1. Under paragraph 40401b, delete subparagraph (2) in its entirety.

2. Add new paragraph 40401f, to read as follows:

"Death of Member. Effective 10 Feb 1996, if a member dies while on active duty (or if a member or former member dies after retirement or discharge, but before receiving payment of accrued leave), payment for accrued leave shall be based upon the unused accrued leave the member carried forward into the leave year during which he died plus the unused leave that accrued to him during that leave year. In such cases, the limitation on payment for more than 60 days leave accrual discussed in paragraph 40401a does not apply."

3. Under paragraph 40405.b., delete the parenthetical phrase:

"...(exceeding 60 day ceiling only when authorized in accordance with paragraph 40401b(2))..."

4. Under Table 4-4-1, delete the following rules in their entirety:

Rules 9, 10 and 11.

5. Under Table 4-4-1, renumber Rule 12 as Rule 9.

6. Under Table 4-4-1, make the following change to Note 8:

Replace the second sentence with, "See paragraph 40401b for contingency operation exception and paragraph 40401f for exception where a member dies while on active duty".

7. Under Bibliography, make the following changes:

Delete reference to paragraph 40401b(2) and both citations thereunder.

Add reference to new paragraph "40401f" and the citation "Public Law 104-106, Section 641, 10 Feb 1996".
