1. Delete the current paragraph 60206a.
2. Add new paragraph 60206a to read:

"60206a. The Secretary of the Service concerned or the Secretary's designee determines that a member is indebted to the United States under the authority of 5 U.S.C. 5514. The designated agent listed below is responsible for receiving these collection requests:

3. Add new paragraph 60206b to read:

"60206b. Collection may be made in monthly installments or at established pay intervals not to exceed 15 percent of disposable pay for any pay period, unless a greater percentage is authorized by written consent of the member. Unsatisfied debts at discharge or retirement shall be deducted from subsequent payments of any nature due the member."

4. Renumber current paragraph 60206b to 60206c.
