SUBJECT: Combating Trafficking In Persons Training Report


Trafficking in persons (TIP) is a worldwide problem posing a transnational threat involving violations of basic human rights. TIP is a leading source of profits for organized crime, together with drugs and weapons, generating billions of dollars. Trafficking in persons affects virtually every country in the world.

The Department of Defense has a zero tolerance policy for TIP. Awareness training is mandatory for all DoD military members and civilian employees. The training is available online at: www.jkddcjmo.org [Public View: <http://www.dodig.mil/Inspections/IPO/combatinghuman.htm>].

Paragraph 5.1.9, DoD Instruction 2200.01(February 16, 2007), *Combating Trafficking in Persons (CTIP)*, charges the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Personnel and Readiness), in coordination with the Military Services, to establish a metric to track TIP awareness training and understanding of TIP-related policy and programs.

To capture data on training awareness, a DoD TIP report will be generated. The first report will be for Fiscal Year 2007. The performance measures for the program to be reported are the two awareness training requirements for military members and civilian members, based on the end strength for each, as outlined in the attached summary from a TIP metrics conference held at the Defense Manpower Data Center. In addition, the Military Services are to present information as to which leadership institutes they have or will have TIP training required by paragraph 5.9.1, DoDI 2200.1, for both enlisted personnel and officers.
