COLONEL ROBERT L. SWANN

Colonel Robert L. Swann has been selected to be the Department of Defense (DoD) Office of Military Commissions (OMC) Chief Prosecutor. He is responsible for drafting charges and directing the overall prosecution efforts of the United States in military commissions. His duties include supervising all Military Commission Prosecutors and Assistant Prosecutors.

Colonel Swann has twenty-six years of experience as an Army judge advocate and more than twenty years litigation experience as a government trial attorney, defense counsel, appellate attorney and judge. Colonel Swann entered active duty in 1978, after receiving his Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Tennessee in 1974 and Juris Doctorate from University of Memphis in 1977. Prior to selection as the Chief Prosecutor, Colonel Swann was assigned as a Circuit Judge in the Army's 2nd Judicial Circuit at Fort Campbell, KY, becoming the Chief Circuit Judge in 2001.
