



**THE HONORABLE G. KIM WINCUP**

G. Kim Wincup is Chairman of the Reserve Forces Policy Board which serves as a principal policy adviser to the Secretary of Defense.

The Board was created by Congress in 1952 to independently monitor, review and evaluate proposals, policies and actions affecting the Reserve Components, and to prepare an annual report to the Congress and President.



Mr. Wincup was appointed the RFPB Chairman in November 2006. He served in the military as an Air Force Judge Advocate from 1970 to 1973. Mr. Wincup also served the Defense Department as Assistant Secretary of the Army for Manpower and Reserve Affairs from 1989 to 1992, and as Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition in 1992.

His staff experience with the U.S. Congress included service as Assistant General Counsel, then Counsel, to the House Armed Services Committee from 1974 to 1984; as Staff Director of the House Armed Services Committee from 1984 to 1989; and as Staff Director of the Joint Committee on the Organization of Congress in 1993.

Mr. Wincup graduated from DePauw University in Chicago with a bachelor of arts degree in political science in 1966. In 1969 he earned a law degree from the University of Illinois. Mr. Wincup has served as a Visiting Professor of National Security Affairs to the Naval Postgraduate School.

In his civilian capacity Mr. Wincup is Senior Vice President for Corporate Development with the Science Applications International Corporation.
